 be at Dividing Creek on the Twenty Sixth day of Jany then next following - at which day
 the said Sher. with severall of the Justices of the County & with the Clerk of the County Court and
 the severall free holders and others qualified to give a vote in the Election & did give their
 Vote and Elect Geo. Seoni Gale Esq. Robert King M^r W^m Stoughton and Majr. Robert Jenkins
 Henry as Burgeses for the County &c &c
