The petition aforesaid being read and fully understood Wherefore it is considered  
that a commission Issue to the aforesaid David Wallis as by the petition aforesaid  
is prayed and that Alexander Lawrie Day Scott Charles Dashiel and  
George Dashiel Junr. of Somerset County Gent. be Commissioners and execute  
the same Commission according to act of assembly in such case made and provided  
be

James Owens (son of Samuel Owens late of Somerset County  
W<sup>m</sup> Owens his father deceased) an orphan above the age of fourteen years came hereinto  
Court in his proper person and prayeth that he may be admitted  
to choose a certain William Owens as his Guardian which is by the Court hereunto  
him granted &c. Herupon the said James Owens present herein Court as aforesaid makes  
choice of the said William Owens as his Guardian. Whereupon the said William  
Owens is ordered by the Court here to take into his care and tuition the aforesaid James  
and that a certain Emanuel Maylove deliver the same to the aforesaid Guardian &c.  
Owens and all his estate both real and personal, and likewise that he give good  
Security for to comply with the guardian ship aforesaid.

Thereupon the said William Owens with James Strawbridge and George  
Bowthor both of Somerset County planters his security all present herein Court in  
their proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto the said James  
Owens in the sum of One hundred pounds Current money of Maryland of their body's  
Goods or Chattells Land or tenements joyntly and severally to the use of the  
said James Owens his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns to be made &  
Searched if it happen that the said William Owens doe not comply with the  
Law in relation to the guardian ship aforesaid and doe not deliver up unto the said  
James Owens his heirs Executors Administrators or assigns all his estate both real  
and personal (that he shall take into his hands and possession) peaceably and  
quietly whenever the same should be legally required &c.

York negro Boy of Robert Richardson being present here in Court is adjudged  
by the same Court to be now of the age of twelve years &c.
