The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Commissary Gen<sup>l</sup> hath transmitted unto this Court the Account of the Estate of James Burnett dec<sup>d</sup> wherein it is found that there is Bal<sup>d</sup> due to the above said orphans the Sum of fourteen pounds one Shilling and four pence Curr<sup>t</sup> if therefore the above said William Jones Francis Henderson or James Burnett their heirs Ex<sup>ts</sup> and Adm<sup>rs</sup> or either of them do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said orphans the said sum of fourteen pounds one Shilling and four pence in equal parts and portions according to Act of Assembly when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same & when the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain full force and virtue &c.
