Know all men by these presents that we James Breman Francis Allen James Baker and George Layfeild all of Somerset County in the province aforesaid are holden and firmly bound unto Mary Layfeild Thomas Layfeild and Levina Layfeild orphans of Thomas Layfeild dec^d in the full and just sum of Two hundred and six pounds pounds Eight shillings and two pence current money of Maryland to be paid unto the said Mary Thomas and Levina Layfeild their heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} or assignes to the which payment well and truly to be made and done we bind ourselves our and either of our heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} for the whole and in the whole jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 22th Day of March Anno Domⁱ 1737.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Com^{missary} Gen^l hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the estate of Thomas Layfeild dec^d wherein it is found that there is balt due to the above said orphans the sum of one hundred and three pounds four shillings and one penny if there fore the above said James Breman his heirs Ex^{rs} and Adm^{rs} or any of them shall well and truly pay or Cause to be paid unto the afo^r orphans the sum of one hundred and three pounds four shillings and one penny to be paid them according to act of assembly and dece^d will when they shall arrive at full age to receive the same &c then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in force and vertue &c
