heirs Ex^t or Adm^t shall and do well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the abovesaid
orphan the aforesum of fifty two pounds fifteen shillings and nine pence according to act
of Assembly and the dece^d will when she shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the
above obligation to be void and of none effect other wise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
