And afterwards in the same Court before the Justices here of came John Dennis Jus<sup>t</sup>. late of Somerset County Deli<sup>ver</sup>er in his proper person and undertook for the same William Lewis and affirmed upon himself [Likewise the same W<sup>m</sup> Lewis present here in Court in his proper person affirmed upon himself] that if it should happen that Judgment in the place aforesaid in the same Court should be rendered for the same Daniel Carrol against the said William Lewis or that he the said William Lewis should be thereon convicted, that then he the said William Lewis should pay and deliver unto the aforesaid Daniel Carrol the Judgment of the Court thereon or render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the Sheriff of the County aforesaid to remain until the same Judgment be satisfied unto the same Daniel Carrol or that he the said John Dennis Jus<sup>t</sup>. will do the same for him.

Whereupon the said William Lewis in his proper person came & defied all the force of injury which he and upon his day is given to the parties aforesaid here until the third Tuesday of June then next following a/c.

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Daniel Carrol by his attorney aforesaid as the aforesaid William Lewis in his proper person, and Whereupon the aforesaid John Dennis Jus<sup>t</sup>. bail of the aforesaid William Lewis being present here in Court before the Justices here of delivered up unto the same Court the Body of the same William Lewis in discharge of his recognizance of Bail aforesaid entered into a/c for the aforesaid William Lewis.

Whereupon at the prayer of the aforesaid Daniel Carrol by his attorney aforesaid the aforesaid William Lewis is adjudged by the Justices aforesaid to give other bail to the aforesaid unto the same Daniel Carrol but for want whereof the same William Lewis is committed by the same Justices here into the custody of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid to remain a/c until a/c. the same Sheriff to wit Joseph Mifflin Gentle present here in Court by Francis Parker his deputy took charge of the same William Lewis accordingly and thereupon further day is given to the parties aforesaid here until the third Tuesday of August then next following a/c.

At which day here before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Daniel Carrol by his attorney aforesaid as the aforesaid William Lewis in his proper person and whereupon further day is given to the parties aforesaid until the third Tuesday of November then next following a/c.

All which day before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset at Dividing Creek came again as well the aforesaid Daniel Carrol by his attorney aforesaid as the aforesaid William Lewis in his proper person in custody of the Sheriff aforesaid and Whereupon the said Daniel Carrol declared against the said William Lewis in custody a/c upon the Writ aforesaid vizt. Somerset County vs. William Lewis late of Somerset County planter otherwise called William Lewis now of Somerset County planter was intimated to answer unto Daniel Carrol of a pleathat he render unto him forty two pounds curr<sup>t</sup>. money of Maryland which to him he oweth and unjustly detaineth a/c And Whereupon the same Daniel by William Beckingham his attorney saith that whereas the aforesaid William Lewis the ninth day of October anno domini seventeen hundred thirty and one
