Whereupon the said Ann Hughes with Thomas Shownb Late of Somerset County Taylor her security both the present herem Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in the Sum of fifty pounds Curr. money of their body, goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to the Use of the Inhabitants of the County and their Successors to be made and Levied, If it happen that the said Ann Hughes her heirs Executors or Administrators or any of them do and Shall not from time to time and at all times forever hereafter acquit and save harmless as well the Justices of Somerset County and their Successors for the time being as also the Inhabitants of the said County of and from all Costs Charges trouble and Inconveniences whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and bringing up of the said Child lately on her body begott and doe not keep themselves indemnified of &c. from all other such Charges trouble and demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same &c. Likewise it is Ordered by the Court here that the said Ann Hughes give security for the payment of the Severall Officers fees due by Quasion of the premises afo. on the Indictment aforesaid &c.

Whereupon the said Ann Hughes with the said Thomas Shownb both present herem Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Indebted unto the Severall Officers of Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Indictment afo. in five hundred pounds of Curr. money of their body, goods or Chattels Lands or Tenements to the Use of the Severall Officers afo. their heirs or assigns to be made and Levied In case the said Ann Hughes do not pay and satisfy unto the Severall Officers afo. their just and right full fees or fees on the Indictment aforesaid &c.
