Gale of Twelve Jurors being presented that Jeremiah Gray late of Allhollows parish in Somerset County
planter the last Day of September ann^d 1737. One thousand seven hundred and thirty ^{seven} at the
parish afo^r in the County afo^r within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication with a certain
Ann Hughes and then and there had carnal knowledge of her body and did begett then and there abas-
sard child on the body of her the same Ann Hughes to the high displeasure of Almighty God
to the evil example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord-prov^{er}
that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the act of assembly in
such case made and provided &c.

And now to witte the third Tuesday of March being that same term before his said
Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came the said Jeremiah Carey in his proper person &
had allowance of the Indictment afo and saith that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of
the premises in the Indictment afo specified in manner & form as by the Indictment afo
above against him supposed and the premises afo expressly acknowledgeth and is
willing to pay his fine for the fact afo &c. Whereupon all and singular the premises
by the Court have been heard and fully understood - It is considered that the said Jeremiah
Carey pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court here upon him im-
posed thirty Shillings Curr. Money of Maryland to the use of the County afo and that the said
Jeremiah Carey be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine afo &c.

Whereupon it is Ordered by the Court here that the said Jeremiah Frey give Security for the payment of the severall Officers fees due on the Inditment afo^{re} Thed upon the said Jeremiah Frey with Thomas Stowm late of Somerset County Taylor his Security both present before the Court in their proper persons acknowledged themselves Subjetted unto the severall Officers of Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Inditment afo^{re} in five hundred pounds of tobacco of their bodies goods or Chattels Lands or tenements to the use of the severall Officers their heirs or assigns to be made and Levied - In case the said Jeremiah Frey doe not pay & satisfy unto the severall ^{Officers} afo^{re} the Just and rightfull fees or fees due on the Inditment afo^{re}
