phry Chapman of the same parish and County planter and Martha Handlin of the same parish
and County being then and yet at the place of the wife of Patrick Handlin (the said Humphry and
Martha then and still residing and living within the said parish County and Jurisdiction) did cause
notice to be given unto the aforesaid Humphry and Martha to appear before them the said Minister Vestry
and Church Wardens on the tenth Day of July in the said year last mentioned at a Vestry then held
by them in the parish Church of the said parish in the parish and County aforesaid and that the said
Humphry and Martha then and there appeared before the said Minister Vestry and Church Ward-
ens (the same Humphry and Martha having on the said tenth day of July in the said year
last mentioned Notice given them so to do) and the same Humphry and Martha were acquai-
nted then and there by the said Minister Vestry and Church Wardens of the suspicion that
was had of the Incontinency of them the said Humphry and Martha and were admonished then
and there by the same Minister Vestry and Church Wardens from accompanying together
and frequenting the Company of each other the said Humphry and Martha having not executed
or acquitted themselves of the grounds of the said suspicion in such Manner as the said Mini-
ster Vestry and Church Wardens did approve and the aforesaid Attorney doth give the Justices here fur-
ther to understand and be informed that the aforesaid Humphry Chapman of the said parish and County
planter did afterwards to wit the first Day of August anno Domini Seventeen hundred thirty and Seven aforesaid
and divers other times as well before as since at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid and within the Jurisdic-
