Whereupon the said John Robins is ordered to give security for all the Officers fees due upon the premises aforesaid. Thereupon the aforesaid George Douglas present before the Court in his proper person undertook for the same John Robins for the payment of the several Officers fees by means of the premises aforesaid.
