saith that he cannot deny but that he is guilty of the trespass and assault aforesaid in the Indictment
aforesaid specified above upon him Imposed in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid above of
him Imposed and the trespass and assault aforesaid in the Indictment aforesaid expressly acknowledged &c.

Whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court have been heard & fully understood. It is considered
that the said Downock Dennis pay unto his said Lordship the Lord proprietary for his fine by the Court
here upon him Imposed for and by reason of the trespass and assault aforesaid whereof in form aforesaid he is
guilty five Shillings Curr. money of Maryland and that the said Downock Dennis be taken to satisfy
his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid.
