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that now is his good rule and Government and against the form of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided &c.

And now to wit the third Tuesday of March at that same term before his said Lordships Justices at dividing Creek came the said William Evans according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Security in that part first acknowledged and being by the Sheriff Led to the Bar in his proper person, who is thereupon committed into the Custody of the same Sheriff &c. and Instantly the said William Evans is asked how he of the felony aforesaid upon him Imposed will therof acquitt himselfe saith that he is in no sort guilty thereof, and therupon of good and Will puts himselfe upon the Country and Robert Duckins Henry Gants. who for his said Lordship in this part followeth Likewise — Therefore let Come Immediately thereof the Jury before his said Lordships Justices at dividing Creek this Instant third Tuesday of March by which &c. and who he to require &c. because &c. and the Jurors of that same Jury by the Sheriff of the County aforesaid to this Impannelled vizt Edmund Hough Thomas Dixon Capell King Isaac Marshall Robert Michale Moses Chille William Venable John Fleming John Roach James Strawbridge Solomon Long Nathaniel Waller Junr. being called Came who to say the truth of the premises being elected tryed and sworn say upon their Oath that the aforesaid William Evans is guilty of the felony aforesaid ^{above} upon him in form aforesaid Imposed, in manner and form as by the Indictment aforesaid against him supposed — Wherupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court fully understood &c.

Thereupon the Court here according to act of assembly in such case made and provided Valued the Shirt in the Indictment aforesaid mentioned to ten Shillings current money of Maryland.

And It is Considered that the said William Evans pay unto John Boyce the party grieved forty Shillings current money of Maryland being four fold of the Value of the Shirt aforesaid valued and mentioned in the Indictment, to be Stolen. and that the said Wm. Evans stand in & upon the pillory at dividing Creek in the County aforesaid the space of a quarter of an hour and Likewise that he be whipt with fifteen Stripes at the publick whipping post at the place aforesaid on the Bars Bank Well Laid on until the Blood appear and that the said William Evans be taken &c. Thereupon as to the Corporal punishment aforesaid Command is given to the Sher. of the County aforesaid that he do therof Immediate Execution according to the Judgment aforesaid rendered by
