Alkison, for three hundred and ninety pounds of tobacco &c.

to give evidence for his Lordship against Wm. Evans and are discharged therefrom.

Joanna Collins appears herein Court according to her recognizance entered into for her appearance
and good behaviour to this Court and is discharged therefrom. Whereupon it is ordered by the
Court that the said Joanna Collins give security for the payment of the severall Officers their
fees due by means of the premises of the said Evans. Thereupon James West of Somerset County planter
present herein Court undertook for the said Joanna Collins and acknowledged himself indebted unto
the severall Officers that hath right to any fee or fees on the premises of the said Evans in five hundred pounds
of tobacco of his body, goods, or chattells ^{the portion of a biggins} Land, or tenements to the use of the severall Officers,
that have a right to any fee or fees on the premises of the said Evans to be made and levied if it happen
that the said Joanna Collins do not pay and satisfy unto the severall Officers of their just
and right full fees or fees by means of the premises of the said Evans.
