Advised Ignoramus Robert Jones foreman. And now to wit the third Tuesday of
month ~~at~~ that same Term before his Lordship Justice of the Peace came the aforesaid
Robert Spear in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance by him and his Surety
before ~~in~~ that said and acknowledged and prays that his appearance may be recorded & he and
his Surety discharged. Whereupon the said Robert Spear's appearance is recorded and he
and his Surety accordingly discharged &c. Whereupon the said Robert Spear is
ordered to give security for the payment of the severall officers fees due by means
of the premises and Indictment aforesaid. Whereupon the said Robert Spear
with Henry Spear of Somerset County planter present herein Court in ~~their~~
proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto the severall officers of
Somerset County Court that hath a right to any fee or fees on the Indictment
and premises aforesaid. In five hundred pounds of tobacco of their bodies goods or
Chattles Lands or tenements to the use of the severall officers aforesaid their
heirs or assigns to be made and levied In case the said Robert Spear
do not pay and satisfie unto the severall officers aforesaid their Just and right full
fee or fees due on the Indictment and premises aforesaid.

Thomas Caldwell and James Parramore appear herein Court in their proper persons
according to a certain Recognizance by them before acknowledged to give evidence on behalfe
of his Lordship against Robert Spear and are discharged therefrom &c.
