 understand and be Informed that Elizabeth Longo late of Stepten parish
 in the County afo^r Spuister the twentieth day of May Anno Domini one thous-
 and seven hundred and thirty six at the parish afo^r in the County afo^r and
 within the Jurisdiction of this Court did committe fornication ^{with a bastard} Richard Jones
 and did permit the same Richard Jones then and there to have carnal knowledge
 of her body and then and there to begett a bastard child on the body of her the
 same Elizabeth to the high displeasure of almighty God to the evil example
 of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord
 Proprietary that now is his good rule and government and against the form
 of the act of assembly in such case lately made and provided &c.
 Whereupon the said attorney of the said Lord Proprietary for the said
 Lord Proprietary prays the advice of the Court herein the premises and
 that due process of Law in this part against the said Elizabeth may be--
 made to answer the same Lord Proprietary of and upon the premises &c.
 And now to wit the Third Tuesday of March being the Twenty first day of the same month
 and ~~year~~ One thousand seven hundred and thirty seven at that same term before his
 Lordships Justices at Dividing Creek came the said Elizabeth Longo in her proper person
 according to a certain Recognizance by her and her Security before in that part acknow-
