Wine is now with Child by him the said Terrence Galasby by which -
when Born will be abated if therefore the said Terrence Galasby shall
personally ^{appear} before his Lordships Justices of the peace all a Court to be held for
the County of the third Tuesday of this Instant month at Dwiding Creek and
then and there to receive and abide what shall be enjoined by the said Court
Concerning the premises and in the mean time to be of the good behaviour then
the above Recognizance to be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and
virtue in Law And now with the third Tuesday

of March at that same term before his Lordships Justices at Dwiding Creek came
the said Terrence Galasby in his proper person according to a certain Recognizance
by him and his Security for that part before acknowledged and prays that his appear-
ance may be recorded and he and his Security discharged. Whereupon the said
Terrence Galasby's appearance is recorded and he and his Security accordingly
discharged. Thereupon the said Terrence Galasby is ordered to give now
Security for his appearance before his Lordships Justices at Dwiding Creek the third
Tuesday of June the next following to answer the premises as aforesaid.

Whereupon the said Terrence Galasby with Richard Knight and
Henry Reynolds his Securitys both of Somerset County present before him in their
proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his Lordship the Lord
Proprietary that is to say the said Terrence Galasby in ten pounds Sterling and
the said Richard Knight & Henry Reynolds in five pounds Sterling each of their
goods and Chattels Land or tenements severally to the use of his said Lordship his
heirs and Successors to be made & Levied If it happen that the said Terrence
Galasby do not make his personal appearance before the Justices of his Lordships
County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dwiding Creek the third Tuesday of June the next
following and do not answer unto his said Lordship of and Concerning the Charge of Bastardy
as and do not stand and abide the Judgment of the Court thereupon and do depart from Court without
leave then -
