

Justices in Court, then held at Dividing Creek in the County of Came the said Edmond Hough by his attorney aforesaid and the Sheriff to wit John Henry Gent. now here returned that he had taken the said William Borter whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the said Edmond Hough of the plea aforesaid as to him it was demanded and further the same Sheriff returned that he had served the same William Borter with a copy of the declaration of according to act of assembly in such case made and provided &c.

Whereupon came here in Court before the said Justice John Wildman of Somerset County Justice in his proper person and undertook for the said William Borter and affirmed upon himself (likewise the same William Borter present here in Court in his proper person affirmed upon himself) that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea of should be rendered for the same Edmond Hough against him the same William Borter, or that he the same William Borter should be known convicted that then he the said William Borter should pay and satisfy unto the same Edmond Hough the Judgment of the Court thereupon or tender his body in execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County of that he remain until the same Judgment should be fully satisfied or that he the said John Wildman will do the same for him.

Whereupon the said Edmond Hough and William Borter both present here in Court in their proper person submitted their dispute in this action to the award of Robert King Esq. according to the form of the Statute and that he made his return thereof in the premise above said between the parties immediately that the Court might proceed to Judgment thereon and afterwards in the same Court before the Justice there of came the said Robert King Esq. the person to whom the aforesaid Submission was made, and returned his award in form following.

Which being read and heard It is considered that the said Edmond Hough recover against the said William Borter the damages of to the said Seventeen pounds, three shillings as by the award aforesaid appears as also three hundred and Twenty Nine pence of costs for his costs and charges of to the same Edmond by the Court here of his award adjudged and the said William in Merry &c.
