

fourteen pounds fourteen shillings and three pence sterling to the said James Waghrop or order according to the tenor of the Indorsement aforesaid and thereupon the said James Bremin afterwards to with the same day and year last mentioned at the place aforesaid in consideration of the premises upon himself did assume and to the said James Waghrop then and there faithfully did promise that he the said James Waghrop should and lawfully did promise that he the said James Bremin the aforesaid three pounds four shillings sterling with all lawfull damages costs and Interests by the said James Waghrop suffered and sustained and by occasion of the <sup>and non payment</sup> non acceptance of the said first bill of exchange as to the aforesaid three pounds four shillings residue of the aforesaid fourteen pounds fourteen shillings and three pence in the aforesaid bill specified when he should be afterwards thereunto requested unto the same James Waghrop would well and truly pay and content and the aforesaid James Waghrop in fact saith that the lawfull costs damages and interests of him the same James Waghrop occasioned by the non acceptance and non payment of the three pounds four shillings residue as aforesaid amount to the sum of thirteen shillings and ten pence sterling whereof the said James Bremin the day year and place last mentioned had notice Never the less the said James Bremin his promise and assumption aforesaid nothing regarding but minding and fraudulently intending the said James Waghrop in this part hastily and Subjectly to deceive and defraud the aforesaid three pounds and four shillings <sup>standing</sup> together with all lawfull costs and damages and Interests aforesaid which <sup>in the whole</sup> amount unto the sum of three pounds seventeen shillings and ten pence sterling or any penny thereof to the aforesaid James Waghrop hath not paid altho to do the same the aforesaid James Bremin to with the same day and year last mentioned and often afterwards at Somerset County aforesaid by the aforesaid James Waghrop was required but that to him hitherto to pay all together hath refused and denyed and still doth refuse and deny to the damage of him the said James Waghrop eleven pounds sterling and thereupon he brings suit &c. - Gledges &c. J. Doc. &c. Proc. - And the aforesaid James Bremin in his proper person comes and defendeth the force and Injury when &c. and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the aforesaid James Waghrop nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesaid James Waghrop above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same James
