

Injury when D. and Saith that he cannot deny the action of the ap Richard nor but that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the ap Richard above against him hath complained and as to the damage of the same Richard by him by occasion of the premises in that part sustained the same John Saith and acknowledgeth that the ap Richard hath sustained damages by occasion of the premises beyond his costs and charges by him about his suit in that part apposed to three pounds ten Shillings and not more and because the ap Richard deny's not this but the same allegation believes to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknowledged together with his costs and charges and to him to be adjudged &c

Therefore by Consent of the parties it is considered that the ap Richard -
Trotter Brewer against the ap John Evans his damages and to the ap three
pounds ten Shillings in form as acknowledged as also Two hundred and Eighty Eight
266 pounds of tobacco for his costs and charges and to the same Richard
at his request by the Court now here of the assent of the parties and adjudged which
certain damages in the whole amounts to three pounds ten Shillings and Two hundred
or Eighty Eight pounds of tobacco and the aforesaid John in Morye
