

Injury wherein he and Saith that he cannot deny the action of the afo' Richard nor but
 that he did assume upon himself in manner and form as the afo' Richard above against
 him hath complained and as to his damage of the same Richard by him by Breachion
 of the premises in that part sustained the same John Saith and acknowledgeth
 that the afo' Richard hath sustained damages by Breachion of the premises beyond
 his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that part appos'd to three pounds
 ten Shillings and not more and because the afo' Richard denys not this but the
 same allegation belives to be true prays Judgment for those damages above acknow-
 ledged together with his Costs and Charges afft to him to be adjudged so.

Therefore by Consent of the parties afft it is considered that the afo' Richard
 Tooke Recover against the afo' John Evans his damages afft to the afo' three
 pounds ten Shillings in form afft acknowledged as also Two hundred and Eighty Eight
 266 - - - pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges afft to the same Richard
 at his request by the Court now here of the afo' of the parties afft adjudged which
 certain damages in the whole amounts to three pounds ten Shillings and Two hundred
 and Eighty Eight - - - pounds of tobacco and the afo'reid John in Money
