four at Somerset County aforesaid by his certain Writing & Obligatory had granted himself
to be held and firmly bound unto the aforesaid Joseph in the sum of Ninety One pounds
One Shilling and six pence aforesaid to be paid unto the aforesaid Joseph when therof three
~~was shold be payed upon the day of the same~~ years
aforesaid Joshua altho' of fact required the aforesaid sum of Money unto the aforesaid
Joseph hath not rendered but that unto him hitherto to render altogether hath refused
and still doth refuse to the damage of the same Joseph Ten pounds and One thousand
pounds of Tobacco and thereof he brings suit & doth bring here into Court the
Writing & Obligatory aforesaid which the Debt aforesaid in form aforesaid doth testify the date whereof
in the same day and year aforesaid Bledges &c J. Doe and A. Rose -

And the aforesaid Joshua Porter by William Goldsbrough his attorney comes and defendeth
the force and Injury wherein &c - and saith that he cannot deny the action aforesaid of the
aforesaid Joseph, Ennalls nor but that the writing obligatory aforesaid is the deed of
the aforesaid Joshua Porter nor but that he oweith the same Joseph Ennalls
the aforesaid Ninety one pounds one shilling and six pence in money and further as
the aforesaid Joseph Ennalls above against him declared -
