And Whereupon the said Joseph by Charles Gold, borough his attorney saith that -
whereas the afo^r Alexander the thirteenth day of August seventeen hundred thirty and four
at Somerset County afo^r by his certain writing obligatory had granted himself to be
held and firmly bound unto the afo^r Joseph in the sum of twenty one pounds one
shilling and six pence afo^r to be paid unto the afo^r Joseph when thereof afterwards
he should be required. Nevertheless the afo^r Alexander altho^r often required the afo^r
sum of money unto the afo^r Joseph hath not rendered but that unto the afo^r him hether
to render altogether hath refused still doth refuse to the damage of the same
Joseph ten pounds and one thousand pounds of tobacco and therefore he brings
suit &c and doth bring here into Court the writing obligatory afo^r with the debt
afo^r in form afo^r doth testify the date whereof is the same day and year aforesaid -

And the afo^r Alexander Fullerton by William Gold, borough his attorney comes
and defends the same and injury when &c and saith that he cannot deny the execution
afo^r of the afo^r Joseph Gunalls nor but that the writing obligatory afo^r is the
deed of the same Alexander Fullerton nor but that he oweth the same Joseph
Gunalls the afo^r twenty one pound one shilling and six pence in manner and
form as the afo^r Joseph Gunall above against him declared.

Therefore it is Considered the afo^r Joseph Gunalls recover against the afo^r
Alexander Fullerton his debt afo^r and his damages by occasion of the deten-
tion of the same debt to:
