whan &c. and saith that he did not assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid  
Duncan above against him hath complained and of this he put himselfe upon the Country &c.  
and after wards the aforesaid John by his attorney aforesaid letteth his verification aforesaid by him above  
protested and saith that he cannot deny the aforesaid of the aforesaid Duncan nor can he say but that  
the said John did assume upon himselfe in manner and form as the aforesaid Duncan above against him  
hath complained and as to the damage of the same Duncan by him by Quasion of the premises  
in that part sustained the same John saith and acknowledgeth that the aforesaid Duncan hath sus-  
tained Damages by Quasion of the premises beyond his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in  
that part assessed to nine pounds sixteen Shillings and ten pence Curr. money of Maryland and  
not more and because the aforesaid Duncan denyes not this but the same allegation believes to be true  
pray Judgment for those Damages above acknowledged together with his Costs and Charges aforesaid to  
him to be adjudged &c.

Therefore by Consent of the parties aforesaid it is considered that the  
aforesaid Murray recover against the aforesaid John Baker his Damages aforesaid to the  
aforesaid Nine pounds sixteen Shillings and ten pence Curr. money of Maryland by the same  
John in form aforesaid acknowledged as also pounds  
of tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesaid to the same Duncan at his request by the Court now here of  
the aforesaid parties aforesaid adjudged which certain Damages in the whole amount to Nine pounds  
sixteen Shillings and ten pence Curr. money and pounds  
of tobacco and the aforesaid John in merry &c.
