And Whereupon the said Thomas by Francis Allen his attorney complains that whereas the said John the first day of January Anno Domini seventeen hundred and thirty five at Somerset County within the Jurisdiction of this Court was Indebted unto the said Thomas in twelve hundred pounds of tobacco for so much by the said John for the said John at the specieall instance and request of the said John to ascertain William Beckingham Gent before that time deposited and paid as also in the sum of forty shillings curr. money of Maryland forsooth by the said John of the said Thomas before that time had borrowed and received and being so thereof Indebted the said John in Consideration thereof the day and year af: at the place af: upon himself did assume and to the said Thomas then and there did faithfully promise that he the said John the said twelve hundred pounds of tobacco and forty shillings curr. money to the said Thomas when he should be thereunto requested he would and faithfully pay and contente Neverthelasse the said John his promise and assumption af: in form aff made nothing regarding butt plotting and fraudulently Intending the said Thomas in that part craftily and subtilly to deceive and defraud the said twelve hundred pounds of tobacco or forty shillings curr. money of Maryland to the said Thomas hath not paid or contented altho the same to the said John by the said Thomas on the af: first day of January in the year af: and often afterwards at Somerset af: he was therunto requested but the same to him hitherto to pay hath refused and still doth refuse and deny to the damage of the said Thomas of twenty pounds curr. money of Maryland and thereupon he brings suit — Pledges &c In Due Prose And the said John Britt by George Douglass his attorney Cometh and defendant the forme and Injury whereof and says that he did not assume upon himself in manner and form as the said Thomas above against him hath complained and of this he puts himself upon the Country and the af: Thomas in like manner —
