

November And Dond one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven and she hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William here also &c. -

At which day here came againe as well the aforesaid William Draper as the aforesaid Frances Bowger by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Frances Bowger prayeth further leave thereof to Impeare here untill the next Court to be held at Desiring Creech in and for the County aforesaid the third Tuesday of March And Dond one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven and she hath it and the same day is given to the aforesaid William here also &c. -

All which day here came againe as well the aforesaid William Draper as the aforesaid Frances Bowger by their attorneys aforesaid And whereupon the aforesaid Frances as before defends the force and Injury when &c. and saith that she did not assume upon herself in manner and form as the aforesaid William above against her hath complained and of this she puts herself upon the Country &c. and the said William in like manner. -

And afterwards the same Frances by her attorney aforesaid relinquisheth the Verification aforesaid by her above pretended and saith that she cannot say the action aforesaid of William Draper nor can he say but that the said Frances did assume upon herself in manner and form as the aforesaid William above against her hath complained nor can he say but that the said William ought to recover his damages against the aforesaid Frances but forasmuch as the damages of the same William by Evasion of the premises is not known, the Justice here at the prayer of the aforesaid William and by the Consent of the aforesaid Frances by her attorney aforesaid and by a Court of assembly in such case made and provided assessed the damages of the aforesaid William by Evasion of the non performance of the promise and assumption aforesaid beyond his costs and charges by him about his Suit in that part assessed to three pounds, five Shillings & Eight pence Curr. money. -

Therefore it is considered that the aforesaid William Draper recover against the aforesaid Frances Bowger his damages aforesaid to the aforesaid three pounds, five Shillings and Eight pence Curr. money by the Justice aforesaid in form aforesaid assessed as
