Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take  
William Porter late of Somerset County Carpenter otherwise called William Porter  
of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Carpenter if he should be found in his  
baily work and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships City  
Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of June and anno  
M<sup>DC</sup>CC<sup>XXVII</sup> thousand seven hundred and thirty Seven to answer unto William Nelson Execut<sup>r</sup> of the testament and  
Last Will of Hugh Nelson of a plea that he render unto him One hundred pounds curr<sup>t</sup> money of Mary-  
land which from him he unjustly detaine<sup>s</sup> &c and the same day is given to the aforesaid William Nelson &c.

At which day here before his Lordships Justice at Alton then held at Dividing Creek in  
the same County came the aforesaid William Nelson by George Douglas his attorney and the aforesaid Sheriff to wit  
Joseph Manchester Gent<sup>r</sup> now here returned that he had taken the aforesaid William Porter whose  
body here at this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid William Nelson of the aforesaid plea as to him  
it was commanded - Whereupon at the same day came hereunto Court Francis Porter of  
Somerset County planter and in his proper person and undertook for the aforesaid William Porter  
and assumed upon himself (likewise the same William Porter present had in Court in his proper person  
assumed upon himself) that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for  
the same William Nelson against him the said William Porter or that the said William Porter  
should be therein convic<sup>t</sup> that then he the said William Porter should pay and Satisfie unto  
said William Nelson the Judgment of the Court thereupon or render his Body in Execution of  
such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid in Satisfaction whereof that he  
the said Francis Porter will do the same for him. - And whereupon the said William Porter  
put in his place Francis Allen Gent<sup>r</sup> attorney at Law against the aforesaid William Nelson in the plea aforesaid

Whereupon at the request of the parties aforesaid day is given to them <sup>to be</sup> before the Justice  
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of August  
anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and thirty Seven in the same State as at present  
sitting to the parties &c. At which day here came again the parties aforesaid by their attorneys  
aforesaid and hereupon the same William Nelson declared against the aforesaid William Porter in form  
following - I Somerset p<sup>r</sup> William Porter late of Somerset County Carpenter otherwise  
called William Porter of Somerset County in the province of Maryland Carpenter was  
summoned to answer unto William Nelson Execut<sup>r</sup> of the testament and last will of Hugh  
Nelson of a plea that he render unto him one hundred pounds current money of Maryland  
which
