

Thereupon it is commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that immediately he should cause to come here before his Lordships Justices Twelve & by whom & to whom neither & to recognize & because as well, and the Jurors of that Jury by the aforesd Sheriff to wit John Henry Gant to his Impannelled to: with Edmond Hough Thomas Dixon, Isaac Marshall Robert Michell Richard Brooks William Venerable John Fleming John Roach James Strawbridge Solomon Long Nathaniel Waller & James Cipman being called unto who to say the truth of the premises aforesd being Elected byed and Sworn upon their Oath Say that the aforesaid Benjamin Townsend did assume upon himself in manner and form as the aforesd Day Scott abrore against him hath Complained and apesed the damages of the same Day further than his Costs and Charges by him about his Suit in that Apesed to three pounds Current money of Maryland and for those Costs and Charges to one pound of the same.

Whereupon the said Benjamin Townsend saith Judgment on the Verdit aforesaid ought not to be rendered because he saith that the declaration and the matter herein contained is not sufficient in Law to maintain the action. — Whereupon all and Singular the premises being Seen and by the Court herefully understood and mature deliberation Whereupon it seemeth to the Justices here that the declaration aforesaid and the matter herein contained are sufficient in Law for to support Judg on the Verdit aforesaid rendered by the Jurors aforesd on behalf of the aforesd Day Scott against him the said Benjamin Townsend.

Therefore it is considered that the aforesd Day Scott recover against the aforesd Benjamin Townsend the damages aforesd by the Jurors aforesd in form aforesd apesed at also 125th pounds of tobacco for his Costs and Charges aforesd to the same Day Scott by the Court here of his aforesd of Increase Adjudged which certain Damages in the whole amount to three pounds Current money of Maryland and

126th pounds of tobacco and the aforesd Benjamin in Money due Whereupon the said Benjamin Townsend prays the Court here to dissolve themselves into a Court of Chancery and that they would proceed to determine the premises above between him and the aforesd Day in Equity according to act of Assembly in such Case provided while is unto him Granted his first giving — Specially to the aforesd Day Scott as well to answer the Damages Costs and Charges above said as all Costs Charges and Damages that might or should be adjudged in Equity. In case the Court of Chancery should decree the same the Whereupon a certain Joseph Dashille of Somerset County planter present before Court in his proper person undertook for the said Benjamin Townsend and affixed.
