Thousand pounds of Tobacco aforesaid and altho' the same Abraham and Martha his wife have been often thereunto Requested the aforesaid Two thousand pounds of Tobacco to the said Day who as well ye have not paid or as yet rendered but the same to the said Lord Proprietary and the same Day Scott who hath hitherto rendered have altogether refused and denied and still to Render do Refuse and deny whereupon the said Day saith that he is the worse and hath damage to the value of Two thousand pounds of Tobacco and thereof he brings Suit <sup>et al.</sup> Plaintiff John Doe R Rose.

And the aforesaid Abraham <sup>and Martha his wife</sup> Ordery by George Douglass <sup>attorney</sup> Esq; & defendeth the same Injury <sup>when</sup> and prayeth leave thereof to Imparte <sup>et al.</sup> Veremable the next Court to be held at Dividing Creek in and for the County <sup>et al.</sup> the third Tuesday of November then next following and they have it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Day Scott who as well he had also done -

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Day Scott who as well he by his attorney aforesaid as the aforesaid Abraham Ordery and Martha his wife by their attorney aforesaid and wherupon the aforesaid Abraham Ordery and Martha his wife pray further leave thereof to Imparte <sup>et al.</sup> Veremable the next Court to be held at Dividing Creek in and for the County <sup>et al.</sup> the third Tuesday of March then next following and they have it and the same day is given to the aforesaid Day Scott who as well he here also -

At which day here came again as well the aforesaid Day Scott who as well he as the aforesaid Abraham Ordery and Martha his wife by their attorney aforesaid and wherupon the same Abraham and Martha as before defend the same and Injury <sup>when</sup> and say that they owe nothing to the said Day Scott who as well <sup>et al.</sup> of the debt in the declaration mentioned and of this they put themselves on the County and the said Day Scott who as well <sup>et al.</sup> in like manner -
