this day and Year first above Written. Upon which was further proclamation made for the said
Lord the King (as the manner is) that if any person would Inform the Court how wherefore
the said Vessel or Boat and the severall goods aforesaid should not be condemned for the Cause
aforesaid or if any would give more for the said Vessel or Boat and severall goods and than the
appraisment of the should come forth and be heard but none so doing.

Therefore it is considered by the Court how that the said Vessel or Boat and the severall goods
and remain forfeited for the Cause aforesaid and that the Lord the King that now is have One third part
thereof, the said Lord Proprietary have One third part thereof, and that the said Edw. Chambers
Esq. have the other third part thereof.

Be it remembered that Levin Gale Esq. Naval

quit tax. Officer of Pocomoke District in the County aforesaid who as well for the Lord
Proprietary as for himselfe Presenteth Comes into Court here this Twenty first Day of March in
the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and thirty Seven in his proper person and gives this
Court to understand and be Informed that after the end of the session of assembly began and held
at annapolis the twentieth day of March in the Year of our Lord Seventeen hundred & thirty
four to wit the nineteenth Day of January in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and thirty
Seven in the County aforesaid within the District of Pocomoke and the Jurisdiction of this Court
he the said Levin Gale seized to the use of the said Lord Proprietary and himselfe the said Levin
Gale who as well for the said Lord Proprietary as for himselfe Presenteth and arrested as forfeited
two Hogheads and three Barrells of Rum imported unto Pocomoke District in Somerset
County aforesaid from parts beyond the Seas by a person to the said Levin Gale unknown because
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
