 hereof, the said Lord Proprietor have One third part thereof, and that the said Edw^r Chambers
 Esq^r have the other third part thereof. —

 Court to understand and be informed that after the end of the session of Assembly began and held
 at Annapolis the twentieth day of March in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and thirty
 four to wit the nineteenth Day of January in the year of our Lord Seventeen hundred and thirty
 seven in the County aforesaid within the District of Pocomoke and the Jurisdiction of this Court
 he the said Levin Gale seized to the use of the said Lord Proprietor and himselfe the said Levin
 Gale who as well for the said Lord Proprietor as for himselfe Presenteth and arrested as forfeited
 two Hogsheads and three Barrells of Rum imported unto Pocomoke District in Somerset
 County aforesaid from parts beyond the seas by a person to the said Levin Gale unknown because
