the Person who Imported the same two Hogsheads and three Barrels of Rum presumed
to Land and did Land the same from on board of some Vessel within the District and County
as and the Jurisdiction aforesaid without delivering any Invoye or making any Entry thereof
to the said Lewin Hale as Naval Officer as aforesaid contrary to the form of the act of
Assembly in such cases provided and therefore the said Lewin Hale prayes the advice of the
Court here in this present case and that the said Two Hogsheads & three Barrels of Rum for the
cause aforesaid may remain forfeited One Moyle thereof to the said Lord Proprietary and the
Other Moyle to the said Lewin Hale according to the form and Effect of the act of Assembly
aforesaid. Whereupon proclamation was made for the said Lord Proprietary (as the man-
ner is) if any person would inform the Court here whiche aforesaid Two Hogsheads & three
Barrels of Rum for the cause aforesaid should not remain forfeited that he should come forth to
be heard and none so to do appearing It is agreed that John Henry Gent Sheriff of
Somerset County be commanded by writ of the said Lord Proprietary that now is under
the seal of this Court that the said Two Hogsheads and three Barrels of Rum by the oath
of Honest and Lawfull men of the said County Justly and faithfully to cause to be
appraised making an Indenture there of between him and the said appraisers &c so that
One part of the said Indenture he have had immediately before his said Lordships Justice
whereon Court sitting at Dividing Creek and afterwards in the same Court the said
Sheriff returne his writ aforesaid together with aforesaid Indenture to the same Writ annexed
of which Indenture the tenor is as followeth videlicet This Indenture made the third day
of April in the Year of Our Lord God One thousand Seven hundred thirty and Eight
Between John Henry Gent. Sheriff of Somerset County of the one part and Robert Graham
and William McCamney of the County aforesaid Gentz of the other part witnesseth that
that wee Robert Graham and William McCamney appraisers according to a writ to
the said Sheriff of Somerset County directed and returned aforesaid have justly measured
and upon oath appraised the two hogsheads and three Barrels of Rum in the said
Writ mentioned at the value of Thirty three pounds Seven Shillings Current money of
this province of Maryland In Writ whereof wee have had a copy set on hands and
signed our Seal the day and year first above written and Upon which was further
Protestation
