

proclamation made for the said Lord Proprietary (in the manor) that if any person would inform the Court here wheresoever the said two Hogsheads and three Barrels of rum should not be condemned for the cause aforesaid or if any would give more for the said two Hogsheads and three Barrels of rum than the appraisement and he should come forth & be heard but none so doing Therefore it is considered by this Court here that the aforesaid Two Hogsheads and three Barrels of rum remain forfeited for the cause aforesaid and that the said Lord Proprietary have the One half thereof, and that the said Lewisham Esq<sup>r</sup> have the other half thereof.

vantage of him the said James Bremin and against the peace of the said Lord pro-  
prietoray that now is his good rule and government
