Before me the Subscriber one of the Lord Proprietarys Justices of the peace for the County of Somerset came Robert Anston and took the severall Oaths to the Government and also the oath of Constable for the hundred of Manney and at the same time subscribed the Oath of abjuration and took according to the directions of the act of assembly in such case provided Given under my hand this thirteenth day of December amongst Anno 1737
