Command was given to the sherriffe of Somerset County that he should take John Bishop late of Somerset County planter if he should be found in his bailiwicks and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at deviding Creeke in the same County the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to satisfie David Wilson of four pounds seventeen shillings Court-money of Maryland and three hundred and twenty eight pounds of tobacco which to the same David in the same Court before the Justices thereof at deviding Creeke were adjudged for his damages which he had by occasion of a certain promise and a pumption to the same David by the asse John made and not performed whereof he is convicted &c. — All which day here came the asse David Wilson by George Douglas his attorney and the sherriffe of Somerset County to witt John Henry Gent. at the same day here returned that he had taken the asse John Bishop whose body hereat this day he had ready to satisfie the asse David Wilson as asse he was commanded &c. — And afterwards to witt the same day and year asse came the asse John Bishop to the bar here led by the sherriffe of the County asse by vertue of the asse Writte to him directed and being asked by the Court here if he was the very same John the same person that the asse David recovered the above damages against or not who say he is Therefore the same John Bishop is committed to the prison of the sherriffe of the County asse thereto remain in safe custody untill the asse David of the Damages asse be satisfied and contented &c. the said sherriffe present herein Court took charge of the said John accordingly &c. —
