William Porter and to the bar here led by the sherriffe afo. by vertue of the afo. Writte to the afo. sherriffe directed and being by the Court here asked whether he was the same William Porter the same person which the afo. Alexander Buncle as well in the debt afo. as in the damages afo. before convicted or not who saith that he is therefore the same William Porter is committed to the prison of the sherriffe afo. thereto remain in safe custody until the afo. Alexander Buncle of the debt and damages afo. should be fully satisfied and contented &c. the afo. sherriffe by Joshua Merrill his deputy present herein Court took charge of the said William Porter accordingly &c.
