

W³B Thomas NewellR²R Henry Wingate.

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should
 have Henry Wingate late of Somerset County planter if he should become
 in his daily walk and his house safe keeps so that he should have his body
 before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held in the Court house at Dividing
 Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of June and about One thousand and Seven hundred
 and thirty six to answer unto Thomas Newell of yeale of his p[ro]p[erty] upon the fault and that
 he of he should not fail him.

All which day here cometh the aforesaid Thomas Newell by William Beckingham his attorney
 and the sheriff of the County aforesaid with Joseph M[ac]Clester Gent at the same day returned
 that he had taken the aforesaid Henry Wingate and him hath here ready according to the
 exigence of the writ aforesaid

Whereupon a certain John Willey ayele of Somerset County planter
 came here into Court in his proper person and under oath for the same Henry Wingate and
 affirmed upon himself [] Likewise the same Henry Wingate present herein Court in his
 proper person affirmed upon himself [] that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea
 aforesaid in the same Court should be rendered for the same Thomas Newell against him the said
 Henry Wingate or that he the said Henry Wingate should be therein convicted that then
 he the said Henry Wingate should pay and satisfy unto the aforesaid Thomas Newell the Judgme[n]t
 of the Court thereupon or Render his body in Execution of such Judgment to the power of the
 sheriff of the County aforesaid thereto remain until the same Judgment be satisfied unto the
 same Thomas Newell or that he the said John Willey will do the same for him.

And whereupon the same Henry Wingate puts in his place Robert Jenkins Henry against the
 aforesaid Thomas Newell of the aforesaid place upon which day is given to the parties to be before his Lordships
 Justices until the third Tuesday of August then next following in the Hall wherein they now sit in the County
 att which day here come before his Lordships as well the aforesaid Thomas Newell as the aforesaid Henry
 Wingate by their attorneys aforesaid and hereupon the said Thomas Declared against the aforesaid Henry in the
 plea aforesaid as follows -- Somerset County to Henry Wingate late of Somerset County planter
 was attached to answer unto Thomas Newell of a p[ro]p[erty] of his p[ro]p[erty] upon the same day

And Whereupon the same Thomas by W^m Beckingham his attorney complains that
 whereas the aforesaid Henry after the first day of May which was in the year of our Lord seventeen
 hundred and five to wit on the second day of May in the year of our Lord seventeen hundred
 and thirty five at Somerset County made his certain note in writing called a promissory note in
