is Court and whereupon it was considered in the same Court that the said W<sup>m</sup> have Execution against the said Henry of the debt and Damages due by the default of him the said Henry &c. At which day here came the said William Colebourn by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to witte John Henry Hart at the same day here returned that he had taken the said Henry Miles whose body here at this day he had ready to satisfy the said William as he was Commanded afterwards to witte the same day and year abovesaid came the said Henry Miles to the bar here seidd in his proper person and whereupon the said William Colebourn by his attorney and prays that the said Henry may be committed in prison until he do pay and satisfy unto the said William six pounds and seven pence in Gold or Silver Maryland Currency and five hundred pounds of Tobacco part of the Debt & Damages due, and of the residue of the abovesaid Debt the said Henry be there quiet &c.

Whereupon the said Henry Miles is committed into the Custody of the Sheriff of the County and there to remain until the said William Colebourn of the said six pounds and seven pence in Silver or Gold Maryland Currency and five hundred pounds of Tobacco be fully satisfied. Afterwards to witte the same day and year abovesaid came here into Court the said William Colebourn by his attorney and acknowledgeth that he is fully satisfied of the said Henry for the said six pounds and seven pence in Gold or Silver Maryland Currency and five hundred pounds of Tobacco. Therefore the said Henry Miles of the said six pounds and seven pence Maryland Currency in Gold or Silver & five hundred pounds of Tobacco be quiet &c.

J.D. John Deal - Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that
