John Henry Gent. at the same day here returned that he had taken the afo^d Matthew Kemp whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the afo^d Christopher Nutter of the afo^d plea as to him it was Comanded. — And whereupon the aforesaid Matthew Kemp puts in his place William Goldborough Gent. against the aforesaid Christopher in the plea afo^d.

Whereupon at the request of the parties aforesaid day is to them here given to be before his Lordship's Justice at the next Court to be held at Diving Creek in and for the County the third Tuesday of March then next following in the same state as at present saving to the parties afo^d.

At which day here came againe the parties afo^d by their attorneys afo^d and the afo^d Christopher Nutter who offered the writ afo^d against the afo^d Matthew in the afo^d plea doth not further prosecute the same writ — Therefore he and his pledger of prosecuting be in Merit and yett the said life name pledger and that the afo^d Matthew Kemp goe thence without day. also it is considered that the afo^d Matthew Kemp recover the aforesaid Christopher Nutter his damages by Omission of the premises by

164 pounds of tobacco to the same Matthew by discretion of the Justice here at his request for his Costs and Charges in that part sustained according to the form of the Statute therof made and provided by the Court here adjudged &c.

Command was given to the sherriffe of Somerset County D. John Lamberson that he should take John Lamberson late of Somerset County Carpenter if he should be found in his bailiwicks and him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held at Diving Creek in the same County the third Tuesday of November Anno Dom^o one thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to answer unto Lewis Powell of a plea of trespass upon the Case &c. — And the same day is given to the said Lewis Powell here &c.

At which day here came the afo^d Lewis Powell by Robert Jenckins Henry his attorney and the sherriffe of Somerset County to witt John Henry Gent. at the same day here returned that he had taken the afo^d John Lamberson whose body hereat this day he had ready to answer the afo^d Lewis Powell of the afo^d plea as to him it was Comanded. — And whereupon the afo^d Matthew Lamberson puts in his place George Douglas Gent. against the afo^d Lewis Powell —
