

Rt. Henry Reynolds -
vs. Richard Hubbard

Command was given to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Richard Hubbard late of Somerset County Bricklayer if he should be found in his body with and him...

should safekeep so that he might have his body before the Justice of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of November ~~and~~ One thousand seven hundred and thirty seven to answer unto Henry Reynolds of plea of trespass upon the Case. and the same day is given to the said Henry Reynolds...

At which day here came the said Henry Reynolds by Robert Debenham Henry his attorney and the Sheriff of Somerset County to wit John Henry Gark. at the same day here returned that he had taken the said Richard Hubbard whose body here at this day he had ready to answer the said Henry Reynolds of the said plea as to him it was Commanded. Whereupon at the prayer of the said Henry Reynolds the said Richard Hubbard is adjudged to give Special Bail to the action of Trespass upon a certain William Barker late of Somerset County planter present herein Court in his proper person undertook for the said Richard Hubbard and affirmed upon himself likewise the said Richard Hubbard present herein Court in his proper person affirmed upon himself that if it should happen that Judgment in the plea aforesaid should be rendered for the said Henry Reynolds against him the said Richard Hubbard or that he the said Richard Hubbard should be liable of removal that then he the said Richard should pay and satisfy unto the said Henry the Judgment of the Court thereupon or tender his body in Execution of such Judgment to the prison of the Sheriff of the County aforesaid in satisfaction thereof or that he the said William Barker will do the same for him.

And whereupon the said Richard Hubbard puts in his plea in answer against the said Henry in the aforesaid plea. Whereupon at the prayer of the parties said day is to them here given to be before his Lordships Justices at the next Court to be hold at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of month then next following in the same state as at present saving to the parties of the...

All which day here came againe the parties said by their attorneys aforesaid and whereupon the said Richard deliver up his body to the Sheriff of the County said in discharge of his bail said. and afterwards according to act of assembly in such case made and provided was returned here the following Instrument of writing in form following Henry Reynolds p[er] p[ro]c. of Richard Hubbard d[ef]t. You Joshua Caldwell do undertake for the said Richard Hubbard Defendant in the sum of thirty pounds Curr. Money of Maryland to be Levied on your lands and tenements goods and Chattels to the use of the said Henry Reynolds the Plaintiff upon Condition that if the said Henry Reynolds do obtain Judgment in an action of trespass upon the Case depending in the County Court of Somerset against the said Richard Hubbard the d[ef]t. that then the said Richard...
