the statute thereof made and provided by the Court here adjudged &c

that he should take Joseph Maclester Late of Somerset  
County Gentleman if he should be found in his baileywick and  
him should safe keep so that he might have his body before the Justices of his  
Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Deviding Creek in the same  
County the third Tuesday of November And Dated one thousand seven hundred  
and thirty seven to answer unto Jacob Lookerman of a plea of trespass upon the said  
All which day here came the aforesaid Jacob Lookerman by Charles Goldborough his  
attorney and the sherriff of Somerset County to witness John Henry Gent at the  
same day here returned that he had taken the aforesaid Joseph Maclester whose  
body hereat this day he had ready to answer the aforesaid Jacob Lookerman of the  
aforesaid plea as to him it was commanded.

And Whereupon the said Joseph Maclester puts in his place Robert Denes in  
Henry Gent against the aforesaid Jacob Lookerman in the aforesaid plea Whereupon  
at the prayer of the parties aforesaid day is to them here given to be before his Lordships  
Justices at the next Court to be held at Deviding Creek the third Tuesday of March  
then next following <sup>to be</sup> in the same state as at present saving to the parties aforesaid &c  
All which day here came againe the parties aforesaid by their attorneys aforesaid and hereupon  
the said Jacob Lookerman declared against the aforesaid Joseph Maclester in the  
plea aforesaid in form following - Somerset for Joseph Maclester Late of Somerset  
County
