All which day here came the ass. Jacob Lookerman by Charles Goldborough his
attorney and the sherriffe of Somerset County to witt John Henry Gent. at the
same day here returned that he had taken the ass. Joseph Macclester whose
body here at this day he had ready to answer the ass. Jacob Lookerman of the
ass. plea as to him it was commanded. —

And Whereupon the said Joseph Macclester puts in his place Robert Dennis in
Henry Gent. against the ass. Jacob Lookerman in the ass. pleas Whereupon
at the prayer of the parties ass. day is to them here given to be before his Lordships
Justices at the next Court to be held at deviding Creech ^{the} third Tuesday of march
then next following ^{to be} in the same date as at present saving to the parties ass. &c.
All which day here came againe the parties ass. by their attorneys ass. and hereupon
the said Jacob Lookerman declared against the ass. Joseph Macclester in the
