All which day here came againe as well the afo^rd John Williams as the afo^rd Martin Fenton in their proper persons, and the aforesaid Arbitrators said, not their award in the premises aforesaid - therefore further day is given to the arbitrators here until the third Tuesday of March then next following for the making and returning of their award in the premises aforesaid and the same day is given to the parties afo^rd there &c

All which day here came as well the afo^rd John Williams as the aforesaid Martin Fenton in their proper persons and the afo^rd Geo: Douglas and Robert Jenkins Henry arbitrators ad idem here at the second day have agreed in the premises and in form following &c
