the 20th day of June 1738. The humble petition of Hugh Stevenson and John Miller

Humbly sheweth. That Whereas last upon the death of Cap^t. William Farit a certain tract of Land was left by his Last will to your petitioners called Bowley containing 200 acres of Land to be equally divided between us therefore for a perpetuity we begg your worship to Issue out a Commission to such persons as you think fitt to settle the boundaries and Division of said tract and as in duty wee are bound to wish the happiness of your worships as your petitioners shall pray.

The petition afo being read and heard and fully understood It is considered by the Court here that a Commission should be issued to the afo Hugh Stevenson and John Miller as by the petition afo is proved and that James Martin Samuel Hopkins Synagaton Isaac Marshall & William Simpson all of Somerset County Gent be Commissioners and Execute the same Commission according to act of assembly in such case made & provided &c.

herewith Court in his proper person makes Chose of the afo Lewin Gale Esq^r as his Guardian &c. Where
upon a certain John Watch of Somerset County Gent deliver up unto the afo Guardian all the Estate
of the afo Lewin Denwood that he hath in his hands and possession both real and personal and
that the afo Guardian receive the same &c. Likewise the said Guardian is ordered to give Security
for to comply with the Guardianship afo &c. Whereupon the afo Lewin Gale Esq^r together
with Robert Denwin Henry and John Dennis Jun^r of Somerset County Gentlemen his Securitys are
present
