rule and Government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such Case lately made and provided Thereupon it was commanded the Sheriff of Somerset County that he Should take the said Hannah Goldsmith late of Somerset County Spinster if she should be found in his Bailiwick and her Should safe keep so that he might have her Body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Thirty Eight to answer unto his said Lordships of the Indictment aforesaid for fornication &c And now to witt the third Tuesday of June before his Lordships Justices at Dividing Creek came the aforesaid Hannah Goldsmith in her proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid and saith that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises in the Indictment aforesaid in manner & form as by the Indictment aforesaid above against her supposed and the premises aforesaid Expressly acknowledgeth and makes Oath that a certain John Griffin is the Begetter of the Child she standeth indicted for and is willing to pay her fine for the same &c

Whereupon all and Singular the premises by the Court here seen heard and fully understood It is considered that the aforesaid Hannah Goldsmith pay unto his Lordship for her fine for and by occasion of the premises aforesaid by the Court here upon her Imposed whereof in forme aforesaid she is Committed Thirty Shillings Court Money of Many Land to the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Hannah Goldsmith be taken to Satisfie his said Lordships of the fine aforesaid Whereupon the said Hannah Goldsmith is ordered to give Security for the payment of the several Officers fees due on the Indictment by occasion of the premises aforesaid Whereupon a certain William Gray of Manocan in Somerset County present here in Court in his proper person undertook for to pay the several Officers fees Due on the Indictment aforesaid In case the said Hannah Goldsmith doth not pay the same her Likewise the same Hannah Goldsmith is ordered to give Security for appearance before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek the third Thursday of August next following to give Evidence on behalfe of his Lordship against the aforesaid John Griffin &c Thereupon the said Hannah Goldsmith for witness William Stoughton of Somerset County hath her Security both present here in
