In Justices in Court sitting at Dividing Creek to answer the Judgment afo'. and afterwards
upon the last day of this term the said Eliz. Smith present Person in Court is discharged from
the recognizance afo' her and her Secundry. Thereupon the said Elizabeth Smith is
ordered to give now Recognizance for her appearance at June Court next to answer
the Judgment & premises afo'. Thereupon the said Elizabeth Smith with Coppel
King her Secundry both present herein Court within proper persons acknowledged
themselves Indebted unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary in five pounds Court
Money of Maryland each of their severale goods and Chattells Lands and tenements
to the use of his said Lordship his heirs & Successors to be made & levied If it happen
that the said Eliz. Smith do not make her personal appearance before the Justices
of his Lordships County Court of Somerset to be held at Dividing Creek in the said
County the third Tuesday of June the next following to answer unto his said Lordship
of and concerning the Judgment and premises afo', and do not stand & abide the
Judgment thereon, and do depart the same Court without leave her.

At which day saw the said Elizabeth Smith altho' Solemly called come
not according to the tenor of the recognizance afo' nor shows cause why &c. and the
said Coppel King altho' at the same day being Solemly called being not in the
said Court as the said Elizabeth according to the recognizance afo' but makes default ther

His Lordship -- Be it remembred that this day vid the 2 day of December anno domini 1737
Abra. Manning appeared before one the Subj: one of his Lordships Justices of the peace for
the County of Somerset Abraham Manning with John Bushop and Elins Pinter
his securities and did then and there own and acknowledge themselves to owe and
stand justly indebted unto the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of Maryland
and vid the said Manning in the sum of fifty pounds Sterling and the
said Bushop and Pinter in the sum of twenty five pounds Sterling each to be void
of their Goods and Chattells Lands and Tenements in a case forfeiture be made of
the Underwritten Recogntizance

The Condition of which Recogntizance is such that if above named Abraham
Manning do make his personal appearance before his Lordships Justices of
the peace for the County afo' at a Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third
Tuesday of March next then and there to answer such writ or may
be
