Justices the peace in the County aforesaid to keep assigned and did acknowledge to give
unto said Right Honourable the Lord proprietors viz the aforesaid Collins Adams in five
pounds and the aforesaid John Hall in five pounds lawful Money of Maryland of these
Goods and Chattles Lands and tenements separately to be made and levied for the use of the
said Lord Proprietor his heirs and successors If default be made in the condition hereunder
written.

The condition of this Recoguizance is such that if the above
bounden Collins Adams shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of Somerset
County Court to be held at Dividing Creek the third Tuesday of this instant June to answer
unto such matters and things as shall be then and there on his behalf objected
against him and that in the mean time he be of the good behaviour to all people especially
towards John White and doe not depart the court without leave the this Recoguizance to
be void otherwise to be and remain in full force and vertue — Whereupon came hereto Court
the aforesaid Collins Adams in his proper person and praye that his appearance may
be recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged. Thereupon the said
Collins Adams appearance is recorded and he and his security accordingly discharged.

Betty Rumbley. } the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of the province of Maryland
held at Dividing Creek in Somerset County aforesaid on the third
Tuesday of June anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred and Ninety Eight before his
said Lordship Justices the peace in the same County to keep assigned by the oath of
Twelve Jurors being presented that Betty Rumbley late of Somerset parish in the County
aforesaid spinner the first day of August anno Domini Seventeen hundred and
Ninety Seven at the parish aforesaid and within the jurisdiction of
this Court did commit fornication with a certain Jarvis Ballard Junior and did permit
the same Jarvis Ballard then and there to have carnal knowledg of her body and to
begett then and there a bastard child on the body of her the same Betty Rumbley to the high
displeasure of Almighty God to the evill example of all others in such case offending
Contrary to the peace of this said Lord Proprietor that now is his good rule and government
