I have considered that the aforesaid Jarvis Ballard stand pay unto his Lordship the Lord Proprietary for his fine by the Court hold upon him Damaged for and by reason of the premises Thirty Shillings Current Money of Maryland to the use of the County aforesaid and that the said Jarvis Ballard be taken to Satisfie his Lordship of the fine aforesaid -
