The nineteenth day of June Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and thirty six

All which said Third Tuesday of August then next here came the said William M^r Gannay by George Douglas his attorney and the Sheriffs of Somerset County to wit Joseph M^r Blaxter Gents at the same day returned that he had attached in the hands of a certain John Evans as the goods and Chattels of the said Thomas Gray to the value of seven pounds seven Shillings and six pence current money of Maryland and fifteen hundred pounds of t^r and that by Christopher Diger & John Doe honest and Lawfull men of this County he had made ^{return} unto the said John Evans that he be and appear at the same day and place aforesaid as by the process aforesaid he was commanded.

And the aforesaid John Evans Garnishee of the said Thomas Gray by Robert Jenkins Henry his attorney comes and prays Leave thereof to imparte here until the third Tuesday of November then next and he hath it and the same day is given to the said William M^r Gannay her also &c.

All which day here came againe as well the said William M^r Gannay as the said John Evans Garnishee as aforesaid and wherupon the dispute in this action is by the Court and Consent of the parties aforesaid referred to George Douglas and Robert Jenkins Henry Gents according to the Form of the Statute and they to return their award in the premises to the Justices of his Lordship's County Court of Somerset to be held in the Court house at Swindrig Street the third Tuesday of March then next following as the Justices may proceed to Judgment & the same day is given the said William and John there &c.

All which day here came againe as well the said William M^r Gannay as the said John Evans Garnishee as aforesaid by their attorneys aforesaid and at the same day the said George Douglas and Rob^t Jenkins Henry Gents their award in the premises aforesaid in form following - Whereas William M^r Gannay and John ^{Evans} Garnishee of Thomas Gray by Court of Somerset County Court made
