

shillings and one penny half penny Curt^l money if therefore the above
said Mitchell Dashiell Geo: Dashiell Es^r and Geo: Dashiell Es^r their heirs
Exors and admors or any or either of them do shall well and truly pay or
cause to be paid unto the afd^s orphans the afd^s sum of twenty four pound
eight shillings and one penny half penny Curt^l money in equal parts
and portions according to act of assembly when they shall arrive at full
age to receive the same &c. Then the above obligation to be void and of none
effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
