





June Court 1738 271

Commissary Genl^l hath transmitted unto this Court the account of the Estate of Abraham Hath dec^d wherein it is found that there is ball^d due to the abovesaid orphan the sum of seventeen pounds eleven shilling and one farthing Court^r money if therefore the abovesaid, Thomas Marshall Jeffery Long and David Dredon their heirs Ex^{ors} and adm^{ors} or either of them do and shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the as^d orphan the as^d sum of seventeen pound eleven shillings and one farthing Court^r money according to act of assembly when she shall arrive at full age to receive the same & then the above obligation to be void and of none effect otherwise to remain in full force and vertue &c.
